Cradle of Humankind and Maropeng

The Sterkfontein Valley landscape is in both western Gauteng and the North West Province and is also called the Cradle of Humankind because it includes remains of hominids from about 2 to 3.3 million years ago. There is also proof of early stone-age, middle stone-age, later stone-age, early and late iron-age and modern people. Thousands of fossils that show human evolution over the past 3.5 million years have been found since 1936. These fossils are important because they show how these human ancestors lived, what they ate and what animals and plants existed with them. Unesco declared it a World Heritage Site **Main Centre Tumulus (emulates an ancient burial mound from the front and stark contrast ,upon exiting (architecture is symbolic journey through the evolution of Life**
